AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open nationwide to all current commissioned officers of the Air National Guard or those eligible to become commissioned officers.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Produces timely and accurate fused intelligence analysis. Uses structured analytical techniques to convert processed information into finished intelligence through the integration, evaluation, analysis, and interpretation of all-source data and the preparation of intelligence products in support of known or anticipated user requirements.
- Produces intelligence from the information gathered by the collection capabilities assigned or attached to the joint force and from the refinement and compilation of intelligence received from subordinate units and external organizations. Integrates, evaluates, analyzes, and interprets all processed information to create products that will satisfy the commander's priority intelligence requirements (PIRs) and requests for information (RFIs).

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Enlisted applicants must meet the age standard of 35 or younger at the time of application and have been pre-qualified by MSgt Vogt 184th Recruiting Office. He may be contacted for prequalification appointments by calling (316)759-7416.
- For entry into this specialty, an undergraduate academic specialization is desirable in science, humanities (especially history, foreign area studies and foreign languages), social sciences (especially political science and sociology), structured analysis (especially statistics and operations research), engineering and mathematics.
- This specialty requires routine access to Top Secret material. Access to SCI and Top Secret material is determined by favorable adjudication of the SSBI and periodic updates, according to applicable security and intelligence regulations.
- Members who are not already qualified will need to attend the Intelligence Officer Initial Skills Course, completion of initial qualification training (IQT) and unit mission qualification training (MQT) for an ISR functional competency; and completion of the ISR 200 Continuing Technical Training (CTT) course.
