MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Temporary Change of Policy to Kansas Army National Guard SOP 385-55: Kansas IDT Fatigue Management Program (IDT Lodging)

1. Due to the current fiscal situation created by operating under the authority of a Continuing Resolution, we must temporarily modify Kansas' IDT Lodging Program. Although Congress passed another Continuing Resolution funding the government until 18 Mar 11, we are still experiencing significant shortfalls in the OPTEMPO accounts. These accounts finance IDT Lodging, POL, Miscellaneous Supply and Services, and CL IX. To meet these requirements, we must modify who is funded to receive the IDT Lodging benefit. This will allow Kansas to continue to fund requirements in support of unit missions while still providing this benefit to those soldiers most in need of the program.
2. The following ranks are authorized to be funded under the IDT Fatigue Management Program.
 - a. Private through Staff Sergeants (E-1 thru E-6).
 - b. Warrant Officer One and Chief Warrant Officer Two (WO1 thru CW2).
 - c. Second Lieutenant and First Lieutenant (2LT thru 1LT).
3. The current guideline contained in the SOP on distance travelled for individual soldiers in order to be eligible for the program remain in effect. Traditional Soldiers that reside beyond 50 miles from their unit of assignment are still authorized one night. Traditional Soldiers who reside beyond 125 miles are authorized two nights. The program is still not authorized for the following personnel:
 - a. AGR, Title-10, or Active Duty soldiers.
 - b. Traditional Soldiers performing duty in an AT, ADSW, or ADT status.
4. This temporary change in policy will remain in effect until the 2011 National Defense Authorization Act is signed into law. Further modification may be necessary if the Continuing Resolution remains in effect after 18 Mar 11.
