SUBJECT: Military Withdrawal Holds

1. Current Military Withdrawals policy applies a hold to a Soldier's GoArmyEd account upon the fourth approval of a withdrawal for military reasons in a fiscal year. This hold, if not deferred or removed by an Army Education Counselor, is automatically removed on 1 October of a new fiscal year.
2. The following changes to this policy will be effective 29 March 2014 with the GoArmyEd Release 8.2: a hold will be applied to a Soldier's GoArmyEd account upon approval of a second withdrawal for military reasons. The hold will not be removed automatically at the beginning of a new fiscal year. Army Education Counselors will retain, defer or remove the hold after a counseling session with the Soldier.
3. Approved withdrawals for military reasons will remain exempt from the current undergraduate/graduate semester hour limit and grade point average calculations.
