**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** Open nationwide to current commissioned officers or those eligible to become commissioned.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Conducts preventive medicine communicable disease control, occupational health, food safety, force health management, and disaster response programs.
- Directs and conducts food safety and public facility sanitation programs. Evaluates food preparation and storage facilities, distributors, equipment, and sanitary practices to assess compliance with public health standards for construction, cleanliness, personal hygiene, and food safety.
- Participates in formulating occupational health examination requirements for workers at risk for hazardous exposures. Maintains close liaison with other agencies to develop procedures for prompt identification, investigation, evaluation, mitigation, and reporting of occupational illnesses.
- Initiates, directs, and conducts preventive medicine and communicable disease control programs.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- For entry into this specialty, it is mandatory to possess either: a Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine (DVM/VMD), or Master's Degree in Public Health (MPH/MSPH) plus a bachelor's degree in a biological science, or Enlisted Public Health Technicians applying to become a Public Health Officer must have a bachelor's degree in a biological science\*, a CCAF in Public Health/Environmental Medicine Technology or allied health sciences, and 7 years of experience in the Public Health career field with 3 years (AD-equivalent) of job experience in AFSC 4E071. (All degrees must be from accredited institutions/programs (e.g. Veterinary colleges are accredited by the American Veterinary Medical Association, MPH programs are accredited by the [Council on Education for Public Health \(CEPH\)](http://www.ceph.org/) (<http://www.ceph.org/>). Applicants must have/maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher on a 4.0 scale.

**\*Bachelor's degree must be in nursing (BSN/RN), biology, entomology, microbiology, or zoology.**

- Enlisted applicants must meet the age standard of 35 or younger at the time of application.
