Comprehensive Resource Management and Credentialing System (CRMCS) Workshop

The CRMCS is a resource management tool developed by the Kansas Division of Emergency Management to enhance the resource management efforts of city, county, and state organizations. This tool further allows emergency response agencies, to include county Ems, state, and private agencies, the ability to credential personnel, provide information on the availability of assets prior to and during an emergency, with the ability to track those assets on scene with near real-time visibility via the internet. Thus helping to facilitate mutual aid and improve situational awareness.

Purpose

This workshop is designed to provide a comprehensive review of the entire system (SalamanderLive, K-SERV, Kansas-Map) and how each of these standalone systems contributes to resource management. The workshop will span from basic concepts to advanced topics allowing both those familiar and unfamiliar with the system to benefit. Operations of the accountability software and hardware (Command, Mobile Express, Rapid Tag, 01 Tag, and 02 Track) to conduct digital accountability.

Scope

There will be training on how to use the database (SalamanderLive) covering all necessary aspects from getting access, entering resource (personnel/equipment), to granting permissions to additional users. The workshop will cover how to use reporting application (SalamanderLive) and how to find the closest needed resources during an emergency using Kansas-Map. Basic concepts of how accountability equipment will be utilized prior to and during an emergency will also be discussed.

Target Audience

The intended audience is all county response agencies (to include county Ems) that have or desire access to their system. Any individual that will be inputting or managing resources within SalamanderLive, printing credentialing badges, and/or using the accountability equipment during an incident. It is strongly encouraged for county Ems to include their agencies within the county to help manage the information in the system and alleviate the burden of performing the task solely.

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FAQs about KS-TRAIN and New User Accounts

- **How do I sign up for a TRAIN user account?**

Log onto <https://ks.train.org>. Click on “Create an Account,” which appears underneath the login on the left hand side of the screen. Review and accept the Terms and Conditions. Fill out all of the necessary information on the subsequent pages. (If you’d like, you can also fill in the optional information.) When you have finished, click “Continue” to enter the site.

- **How do I find courses to take?**

There are several ways to do this. If you have a Course ID Number: enter this number in the “Search by Course ID” box (the second pale-blue box below the Kansas Seal). If you don’t know the Course ID number you can click the “Course Search” link at the top of the screen. From this page you can click “Browse” to view all course offerings in TRAIN, or you can use any of the tools in the “Search Options” list to help narrow your results.

- **I’ve registered for a course – where do I find confirmation of this?**

All of your course registrations can be found by clicking “My Learning” from the home page. This will include all in-progress courses. [With courses offered by Kansas Emergency Management; you can expect to receive an email confirmation from our office within 3 working days after you submit your registration for approval.](#)

- **I signed up for a “Live” course and can no longer attend. Who should I contact?**
