



Council Minutes
Northeast Kansas Homeland Security Council
December 12, 2012

Call to Order- The meeting was opened by Pat Collins at 10:05 am.

Approval of Past Minutes- The minutes for the October meeting were moved to be accepted by Rick Frevert and seconded by Karl McNorton; passed unanimously.

Introductions were made of all present.

Pat Collins talked about Eric Pippins' thoughts from the CEPR meeting. Pippin spoke about future grant programs and felt we all needed to put forth effort to show legislators, both State and Federal, what we have done with past funding. To this end there are plans to have a resource round-up in Salina to show them some of our resources. Dates will be determined soon.

Pat spoke on the Secretary of Transportations' idea to impose user fees on anyone who has radios on the State 800 system. This is to offset the \$8.9 million maintenance budget. It was suggested that the fees be \$100-\$500 per radio per year. Much discussion ensued and a motion was made by Russel Stukey, seconded by Todd Swart, to draft a letter to oppose KDOT's proposal to impose user fees on users of the State radio system. The motion passed.

Fiscal Agent Report:

FY10

- Bomb response team line item still has uncommitted funds
- Replacement cost line item still has uncommitted funds
- Morgue trailer line item still has uncommitted funds
- Haz Mat line item still has uncommitted funds
- Search and Rescue trailer still has uncommitted funds

FY11

- GIS money has been transferred to the State. Jessica Frye was to be the lead on this for the State but is moving to a different job, this program will move to Jesse.
- Bids have been put out for the light towers

FY12

- Bomb squad sustainment- John Cyr is finalizing this
- A contract has been approved for the Batts Armored Vehicle for Lawrence PD

Pat Collins has sent out the roster and everyone should review this and make changes and other updates and send it back to him.

A workshop will be held in Lawrence to upgrade the rapid tag and command systems. Alan Radcliffe will send out dates to affected Counties.

CMCRS-

- All but two Counties in Kansas have started putting resources and contacts in the system.
- A new card design is coming with the main change being the style of the bar code
- A design to allow printing of cards for equipment is in the works
- Mobile express can be linked through the Intertrax exchange now
- When typing resources, use the Federal type if available.

Alan Radcliffe spoke about the IMT deployment to Maryland during Super Storm Sandy.

Regional Coordinator Report- Nancy Lamb

- KDEM has EMAC assessors on site evaluating them.
- Regional Mitigation plan will be starting in 2013
- The State EOC is ready for activation
- Coffey County is host for a Commodity Flow study for 12 counties
- Osage and Franklin Counties have propane and chlorine props
- Radiological officer training- Need a couple of training officers for the NE region-Contact Nancy Lamb if interested.
- Jessica Frye is leaving KDEM and entering the private sector

Pat Collins reminded everyone that they need to make sure all of the 800 radios have been rebanded.

- Projects may be submitted by May
