Council Discussion

Pat Collins congratulated the council members on the wonderful planning and project preparedness.

The 2010 Project outline was emailed out to Council Members. The Kansas Highway Patrol expects project outlines to be ready for the February 18th meeting. No training is involved in the project outline for 2010; 28% of monies will go to law enforcement. Amounts allocated for Northeast: \$371,000; South Central \$204,000; District III \$50,000; \$625,000 to look at Emergency Management scenarios.

Rick and Alan discussed the problems that arose getting the internet provider for the IMT Trailer. A new IMT application is on the IMT website; right now they are only taking position applications that are available. There will be a team meeting in March in Topeka, Emporia or Manhattan.

Pat discussed the notification system with the council. It is ready to be rolled out after several changes during the Beta testing in Franklin and Riley County. Radcliffe asked that the council approve the citizen sign-up form. Brandon Beck moved to accept the Citizen sign up form and web information for IRIS. Todd Ackerman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

FA Report

FY07: Refer to handout. Due May 2010. Alan Radcliffe moved to finalize the LEOP monies of \$2,911.00. Dave Sterbenz seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Barb Jacobson moved to transfer \$2.00 from the Personal Accountability account to the IMT account. Russel Stukeby seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

FY08: Refer to handout. Due May 2011. For the Tech Hazard Call Notification, 10 counties have not accepted the MOU; 12 counties have replied and accepted. Doug Barlet made a motion to hold off on payment through Call Notification until the roll-out is complete to the first ten counties. Barb Jacobson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

KDEM Report – Brandt Haehn & Jonathan York

KDEM is working with the Weather Service to include both the Christmas storm of December 21-27 with the New Years storm. The Public Assist Teams are gathering assessments and are due back to Region VII by February 19. Kansas, Nebraska and Iowa are declaring declarations. FEMA has not given any advice as far as what is accepted. If counties have any additional costs let KDEM know. According to the FEMA Guidance, 3 counties had record or near record snow fall for the Christmas storm system.

Regional Coordinator Report

The State is still waiting on a Crisis City manager to be posted. Crisis City will be KDEM's possession as of April 1, 2010; it will be a free facility for first responders. Crisis City is accepting donations for farm equipment, etc.

Jessica Frye is working on a resource map on the web to be able to locate specific items by county. Two exercise trailers have been purchased and will be located in Crawford County and Grant County.
