Everyone has separate login and password

24/7 technical support

If internet goes down you can physical call them and they can start your system

All emergency call is free no matter the volume or capacity

\$0.07 per connect for non-emergency

About 5,000 people spontaneously

Uses GIS (your maps)

Can print report on the calls

Cell numbers can but how do you know if that is a working number and if that person has a new number?

Can also, do emails

No location distance fees

Can do text messaging for free if you put in a ten digit number and (@) whatever carrier.

Messages are recorded using a 800 number
