

Southeast Kansas Regional Homeland Security Council Approved Minutes

Tuesday, April 20, 2010

President Rick Brown opened the meeting at 10:05.

Approval of Minutes: Kevin made the motion to accept and Larry seconded. Minutes approved.

Fiscal Agent Report: Linda Weldon reported that the 2007 grant ends in May. Jackie stated that we had been given a 6 month extension. 2008 grants are moving along well. Jackie request that some of the training money be moved to equipment. 2009 funds have been released. John Cyr is working on this.

Standing Committee Report

- A. ID and Accountability- No problems here, we are just waiting on the money. Byrdee has received a contact person from each county for the mobile scanners.
- B. Search and Rescue-Chris Way reported that they have a structural collapse class scheduled at Parson Fire and have room for more people. This is an eight day long class.
- C. IMT- Jackie reported that because Nancy has resigned Jason is not going to take over the team management position. Jackie will be manager for now but that we need to be thinking about some else. We were reminded about the Safety Officer training in Sept and Oct. in Pittsburgh. The IMT are short some supplies and equipment that needs to be considered.
- D. Law Enforcement- Ken Parker was not present to report.
- E. Planning- GIS has had several classes. A Conference call needs to be set up for the subcommittees. Planning meeting for 2008 has not been set yet.

KDEM report: Jackie said that the IMT renewal form is on the web site. She also reminded us of the Business and Industry Forum on May 26-27 in Salina and that KDEM has ownership of Crisis City. A new manager, Frank Coots, has been hired.

New Business: 2009 money is being released and we are to go through the project manager issues concerning this.

Announcements: Rose Rozmeriak from the State Fire Marshall, Bomb Unit, stated the regional truck will be ready soon and that it will be housed in Labette County. This truck
