

SCRHSC Minutes 6/10/10

1. Mike Loreg had to cancel the Battle Book Class due to a sudden illness in his family.
2. The Hillsboro Fire Chief presented training on VSAR markings in a disaster.
3. Jason Moses gave an update on the KS 800 MHz radio system and a COMM-L class to be given in Wichita in conjunction with the fall APCO conference this October. COMM-T class next year. Follow up training for South Central and Southeast will be scheduled later in the summer and fall. Please notify Jason if you wish to host training. The State Interoperability Executive Committee will meet with Federal partners on goal 2 of the State Communications Interoperability Plan. Narrow-banding is still on the horizon with the FCC holding fast to the 2013 target date with no extensions of the deadline. Jason also updated the council on the status of site completions throughout the state.
4. Oscar Thomasson updated the 2009 Medical Interoperability Project to provide 800 MHz radios to region hospitals and ambulance service. The project has moved forward and purchased all the equipment to be deployed. Problems with the Sedgwick County template have placed the deployment of radios on hold.
5. Charlie Keeton described the Hospital Emergency Logistics Partnership (HELP) along with providing legacy equipment (UHF and VHF radios for local systems) and getting programming MOU's between hospitals and local license holders.
6. Oscar Thomasson provided a twenty minute class on evidence collection in mass casualty situations including disaster and terrorist scenarios.
7. Michelle Abbott updated the council on the Generator Project. Two bids were submitted and both were over budget for the full nineteen generators. Since Sedgwick County had not submitted the required paperwork despite an extension granted by the Council; its request for a generator was not granted. The council voted for eighteen generators to be purchased. The use of excess funds from this project will be discussed at the next council meeting.
8. De Ann Konkel discussed the HSEEP training and proposed that excess funds from Seth Konkel's project be moved to the HSEEP training to cover over budget costs. Gary Tolle made a motion, Seth Konkel second, motion carried on voice vote.
9. Motion to approve Michelle's 2007 project report De Ann Konkel made a motion, Jerry McNamar seconded and it was carried on a voice vote.

10. Oscar Thomasson made a motion for Chief Jim Daily to be appointed as the Region representative to the Commission on Emergency Planning and Response (CEPR) Law Enforcement Working Group.
