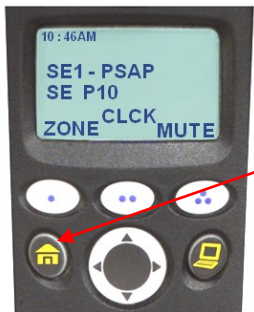
Change Zones

1. Press the soft key under the Zone menu item.

The zone name will begin to blink.



2. Use the left or right arrow on the navigation button to scroll zones.

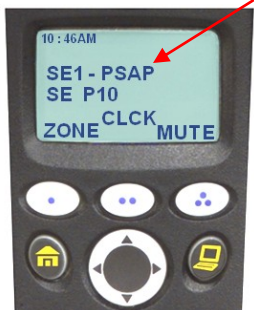
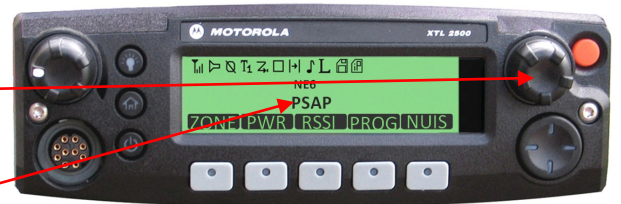


3. When the desired zone is reached, press the home button.



4. Use the channel select knob to

change the channel name.



Motorola XTS & XTL Series Radios



Top Side Button — Press and release to see the tower that the radio is affiliated with and the received signal strength (RSSI) as a number.

PTT Button — Push to talk. Wait for talk permit tone on digital channel.

Side Buttons 1 & 2 — Turns on display light.



RSSI Button — Press and release to see the tower that the radio is affiliated with and the received signal strength (RSSI) as a number.

PWR Button — Shows the programmed power setting (High or Low) of the radio.

Display Dimmer Button — Toggles display brightness (Off - High-Medium-Low-Off)

Power Button — Turns the radio on or off.

Regional Law Enforcement Group - Only affiliates within the sub-zone.

Regional Emergency Management Group - Only affiliates within the sub-zone.

Regional Fire Group - Only affiliates within the sub-zone.

Regional Emergency Medical Group - Only affiliates within the sub-zone.

Regional Public Works Group - Only affiliates within the sub-zone.

Channels 9 through 16 will either be KHP Event Channels or will be unprogrammed. Event Channels are available for legitimate use without further authorization. They are statewide talkgroups.
